



The NEST is a **child-led playscape** exploring an elusive, migrating Creature as it inhabits public spaces.

HAVE YOU SEEN IT?

The NEST makes the **profound ideas of children visible** to the public by giving them agency with story and space as creative placemakers.

Visitors can:

- explore collections of objects, maps, and books to reveal the Creature's story.
- make their own messages and artifacts to add to the space.
- explore identity and accept co-existing difference.
- engage with facilitators to activate The NEST together through playful interactions with creative movement and story interpretation.
